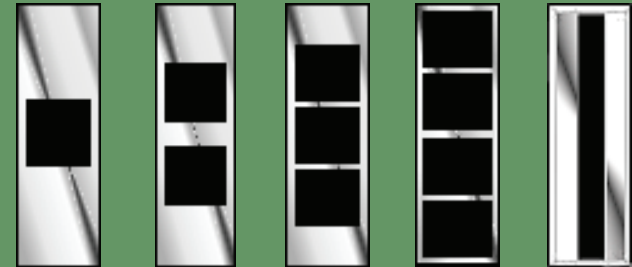

## Do you qualify to become a Warrant Officer?

### General Requirements

- HS Graduate
- Age 18-46
- US Citizen
- Secret Clearance
- GT Score 110 or higher
- Appointment Physical IAW Chap 2, AR 40-501
- Pass APFT
- Meets HT/WT Standards IAW AR 600-9
- Meet MOS requirement

### Additional Requirements

#### Aviator Applicants

- Age 18-33
- AFAST Score 90 or Above
- Cycloplegic Exam
- Class 1 Flight Duty Medical

## Predetermination Packet for Warrant Officers

### Documents required:

- **Commander's** (Unit/BN/BDE) recommendation—must include the following certification:
- “I certify that (name & rank) successfully passed the Army Physical Fitness Test consisting of push-ups, sit-ups and the two mile run with a score of score of (score) on (date); the verified height is (feet& inches) and the verified weight is (lbs).”
- **Certified** copy of DA Form 2-1 (must be certified)
- **Resume** (IAW NGR 600-101- must be dated and signed)
- **Transcripts** documenting completion of required college level courses and courses supporting training related to the applied MOS
- **OERs/NCOERs** covering period of feeder MOS and leader experience required by the mandatory prerequisites
- **Documents** listed on the warrant officer homepage required by the proponent (training/ leadership certificate, DA Form 1059, NGB Form 22, DA Form 214) [www.usarec.army.mil/hq/warrant/index.htm](http://www.usarec.army.mil/hq/warrant/index.htm)

- **Civilian** documents which support training or experience directly related to the MOS (performance evaluations, position descriptions, licenses, others)
- **DA Form 705** (must be within 12 months)
- **Recommendation** from CW3-CW5 who holds the MOS
- **DA Form 5500/5501** (Body Fat Worksheet-if applicable)
